The Application

In order to request funds from the Cheboygan County Community Foundation (CCCF) an application must be submitted. The application form can be found at our website at www.cheboyganfoundation.org. The application requests information about the group applying including its organizational status, its mission, the purpose for which the funds are being applied for, its leadership, and its finances. It is our hope that by completing the application, the group making the request will have an opportunity to give full thought to what it hopes to achieve with the money it is seeking. We stand ready to help if questions arise in completing the application. There may be questions that are not really applicable to the applicant's organization and we understand that and can discuss how those may be addressed.

While applying for any grant may seem cumbersome, organizations like CCCF have a duty to their donors to make sure funds are wisely used and within the parameters permitted by the tax and non profit laws that apply to charitable organizations. Donations given to CCCF are tax exempt but only if we run the organization in accordance with state and federal law.

As with any foundation CCCF has a specific mission and grants must serve that mission. CCCF was formed in 2011 to support projects which create jobs, improve local educational opportunities, increase tourism visits, expand retail and commercial offerings, and enhance the overall economic health of Cheboygan County. In deciding whether to submit an application these goals must be kept in mind since

applications which do not meet them cannot be approved notwithstanding how good the project is. In the past, projects approved have included funds related to studies to show the viability of the Cheboygan Port as well as more recently funds for its marketing, funds for a high school construction class to go to Detroit to learn more about trades, scholarships for middle school students to attend summer seminars introducing them to building trades, and funds for call center training. More recently CCCF has funded leadership training for high school students through the a local golf academy, and funded an artist in residence program which will employ a local artist and provide funds to help create events which will attract tourists and local residents alike.

Once an application is received it will be reviewed by the board member whose responsibility it is to make sure it is complete. If not, the applicant will be contacted and requested to provide any missing information. It will then be acted upon at the next executive committee or board of directors meeting which occurs after the application is received. Depending on the meeting schedule this can be very quickly or take a number of weeks. Once a decision is made the applicant will be notified of the decision.

Applications approved do include an agreement by the grantee that any publicity related to the project include credit to CCCF for its grant. The purpose for this requirement is public awareness of CCCF which is a really important component of our fundraising efforts. When people are aware of a foundation's good works they are ready to financially support it.
